**Yakuoji Temple**

Fee Free

The Buddha of Healing is enshrined as the principal object of worship. In the precincts there is a temple that enshrines the Seven Deities of Good Fortune.



**KI-NO-FURUSATO Traditional Crafts Museum**

Fee Free

Carved floats are displayed. You can try making the traditional craft of wood patterned art. A volunteer is always on site to give explanations on carved floats and history.



**Yatai Float Central Park**

Carved Float Display Museum entrance fee 200 yen

3 floats are displayed, and you can compare the differences in construction by the eras in which they were created. If you inquire at the reception window you can hear an explanation on the floats. There is also a garden and souvenir shop on the premises.

**Machi-No-Eki Shin-Kanuma Juku**

**Oya History Museum**

Fee 800 yen

This is an Oya stone mining site. When you go in through the narrow entrance a gigantic underground space beyond your imagination will appear. Free WiFi connection available in reception area

A Kannon that is 27m tall and made of Oya stone. There is a viewing platform. At the nearby Oya Stone Workshop Facility you can participate in a processing workshop, such as making nameplates using Oya stone.
